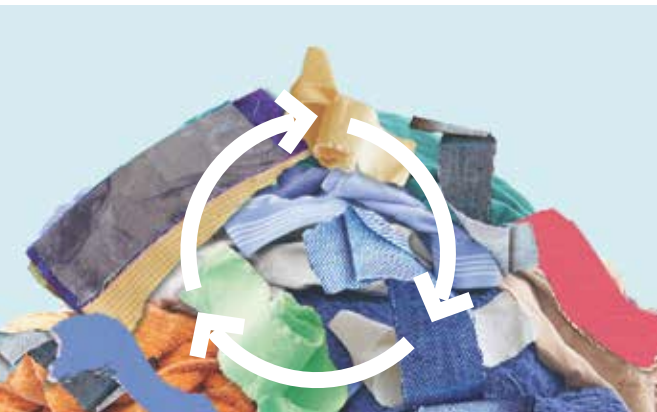

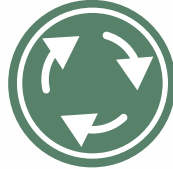

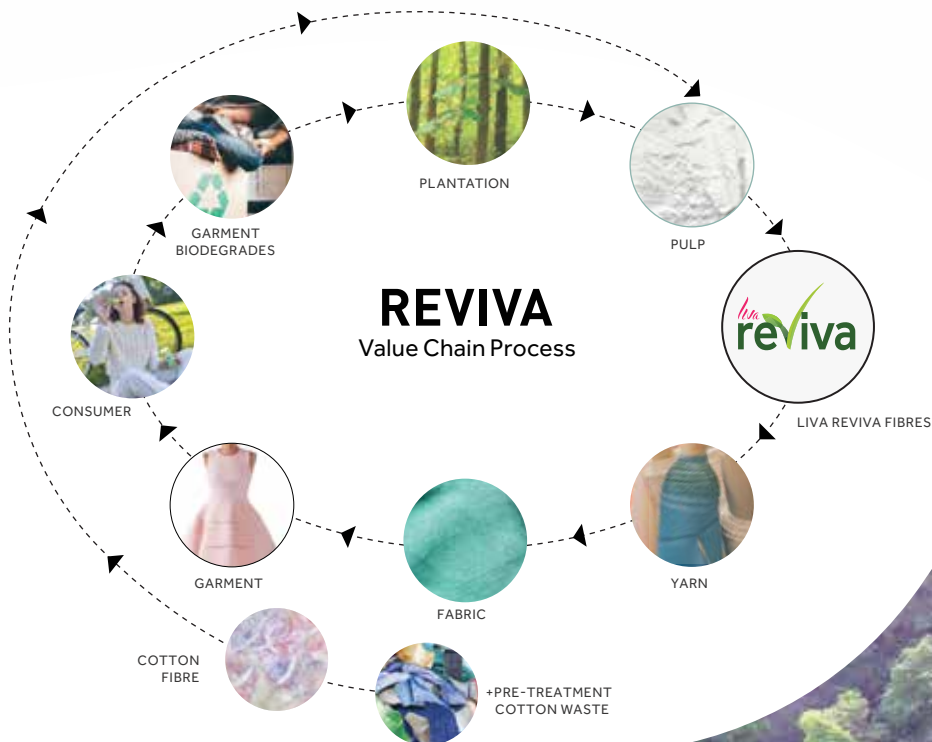

Sustainability at the Core

Liva Reviva™ emphasizes responsible manufacturing while remaining consciously fashionable. Around 15–30% of fabric is wasted during the cutting and stitching of garments, and both **pre-consumer** (production scraps) and **post-consumer** (discarded clothing) textile waste often end up in landfills or are incinerated—placing additional stress on natural resources and contributing to land and air pollution. Instead, Liva Reviva™ recycles this fabric waste and blends it with wood pulp to create a new class of fibres that retain the same high-quality properties as virgin fibres, enabling a more circular and sustainable textile ecosystem.

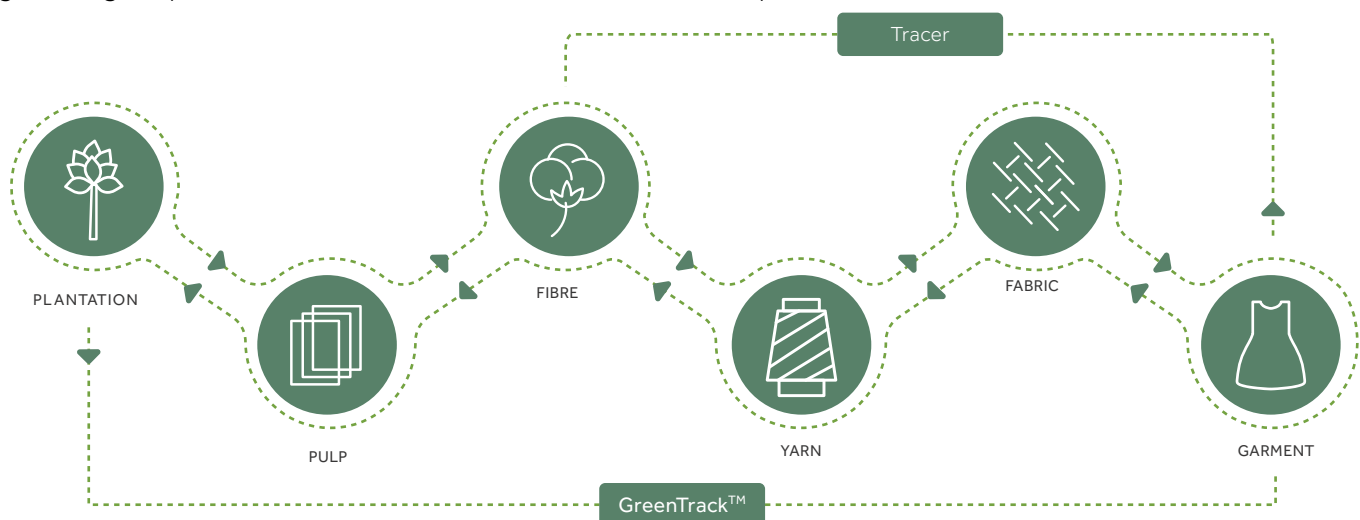


GreenTrack™

Liva Reviva™ is available in two sustainable fibre variants: **Liva Reviva™ Viscose** and **Liva Reviva™ Excel**, each made with 30% recycled pulp and designed to meet global circularity standards. Liva Reviva™ Viscose is crafted using recycled pulp from **CIRCULOSE®** and **Once More**, while Liva Reviva™ Excel uses recycled pulp sourced from **Circ®** and **SaXcell**. Both variants are **RCS (Recycled Claim Standard) certified, fully traceable, and can be mapped using GreenTrack™**
